## SELECTED ACTIVITIES FROM THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION, MARGHERITA COLLEGE

(a) The Margherita College Alumni Association held a Charge Takeover Ceremony for its new committee on November 18, 2023, marking a significant transition. The new committee convened for its 1st Executive Meeting on February 3, 2024, to outline its vision and plans. The Margherita College Alumni Association has initiated a project to build a modern conference hall at the college. On January 30, 2024, a meeting was held between the Principal of Margherita College, representatives of the Alumni Association, and Ms. Panchi Gogoi, PRO of Hindustan Oil and Exploration Company Limited. (b) In a collaborative effort with the Placement Cell, Margherita College, and Satin Creditcare Network Ltd., the Alumni Association organized a successful 'Campus Recruitment Drive' on May 11, 2024, offering valuable opportunities for students and strengthening industry connections.





## SELECTED ACTIVITIES FROM THE FACULTY OF ARTS, MARGHERITA COLLEGE



(a) The Department of Assamese at Margherita College organized several events, including a 2-day educational tour to Majuli (March 12-13, 2024) led by Dr. Runjun Saikia and Dr. Madhumita Deb, which explored iconic satras and enriched participants with new experiences and knowledge. Additionally, the department collaborated with Aakashvani, Dibrugarh, for a panel discussion on "Radio Literature" (January 21, 2024) moderated by Prof. Karabi Deka Hazarika, featuring Prof. Nirajana Mahanta Bezbaruah and Sapunjyoti Thakur as resource persons. The department also celebrated Silpi Divas (January 17, 2024) paying tribute to Rupkonwar Jyotiprasad Agarwala with students reciting poems and performing songs, and faculty members delivering insightful speeches. Furthermore, the department jointly organized a state-level poem recitation workshop with Margherita Poet Association, inaugurated by Dr. Atonu Kakoty, Principal, and led by renowned poet Mrs. Rijumoni Saikia, making all the events a resounding success.

(b) Margherita College celebrated the 163rd birth anniversary of Rabindranath Tagore on May 8, 2024, with a vibrant tribute organized by the Department of Bengali. The event began with ceremonial lamp lighting, followed by an enlightening speech by Dr. Janaki Prasad Debnath. Students and teachers participated enthusiastically, offering floral tributes to Tagore's portrait. In his closing remarks, Principal Dr. Atonu Kakoty urged students to explore Tagore's works and embody his principles to become exceptional individuals. The program's resounding success was a testament to collective cooperation and active engagement.

(c) The Department of Education and IQAC, Margherita College, jointly organized a lecture program on "How to Deal with Academic Pressure" on May 28, 2024, at the Boys Hostel. Ms. Debika Dadhara, Asst. Professor, Dept. of Education presented on stress management, and the program concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr. Koustav Moni Nath, Asst. Professor, Dept. of Assamese with 30 students and faculty members in attendance.

(d) The Department of English at Margherita College organized two notable events: a May 28, 2024, online talk, "Mind Your English: Honing Soft Skills," featuring Dr. Protim Sharma, who emphasized soft skills development to 28 participants; and a February 3, 2024, National Conference and Conclave, "Rethinking English Studies," in collaboration with ELTAI, Upper Assam Chapter, featuring Prof. Mridul Bordoloi and three resource persons, with 113 attendees, including students, faculty, and paper presenters, engaging in blended online and offline sessions.

(e) The Department of Economics at Margherita College conducted two

extension activities: an extension program at Chariali Mazdur LP School on June 2, 2023, where Dr. Jyoti Gogoi, Asst. Professor, Dept. of Economics spoke on developing good habits, and a live telecast of the Union Budget Session 2024-25 on February 1, 2024, providing a unique educational experience on national budgeting and its economic implications.

(f) On November 1, 2023, the Department of History at Margherita College hosted a Career Counselling Programme with Ranjita Academy, Dibrugarh, for 115 students. The event featured presentations by Mr. Madhurjayyoti Gogoi and Mr. Biswajit Ghosh on competitive exam preparation and career opportunities, empowering students to make informed career choices.

(g) Margherita College's Department of Hindi, Assamese, and Bengali hosted a National Talk Programme on May 20, 2024, featuring Prof. Chandan Kumar from Delhi University, who discussed "The Evolution of Indian Theatre". The event included a Satriya dance performance, insights into Makhota culture, and a speech by Dr. Seema Roy Kurmi, HoD, Pol. Science culminating in a vote of thanks by Dr. Runjun Saikia, HoD, Assamese. The programme highlighted the uniformity and diversity of Indian cultural expressions, broadening students' perspectives for future studies.

(h) The Department of Hindi at Margherita College organized and observed several events, including Bibhajan Vibhishika Day, marked by a skit on August 14, 2023, and International Photography Day, observed on August 19, 2023. Additionally, the department participated in the Saksharta Abhiyan initiative, performing a skit at Namdang Tea Estate L.P. School on March 13, 2024, promoting literacy and education.

(i) The Department of Political Science at Margherita College organized two events: a workshop on "Relevance of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)" on September 9, 2023, and a documentary screening program on August 19, 2023, in collaboration with the Department of Economics. Additionally, the department observed International Non-Violence Day on September 30, 2023, promoting peace and academic exchange.

(j) The Department of Sociology at Margherita College hosted three events: a 2-day National Seminar on "National Education Policy 2020" (May 3-4, 2024), a talk program on "Sociology of Music" (January 20, 2024), and an Awareness Program on "Legal Rights of Women and Girl Child" (May 21, 2024). These events featured expert speakers and aimed to discuss policy implications, explore the sociology of music, and empower participants about their legal rights.

## SELECTED ACTIVITIES FROM THE FACULTY OF COMMERCE & MANAGEMENT, MARGHERITA COLLEGE:



(a) The Department of Commerce, Margherita College, organized an educational trip to Majuli on February 23-24, 2024. This two-day excursion provided commerce students with a unique opportunity to explore the island's thriving entrepreneurial ecosystem, experience its vibrant culture, and gain valuable insights into the local economy.

(b) On May 10, 2024, a ceremony was held at Margherita College to distribute course completion certificates to 15 sixth-semester degree students from



the Departments of Commerce and Management. These students successfully finished the Dibrugarh University-recognized Add-on Course in Event Planning and Management, jointly offered by the Dept. of Commerce and Management, for the academic session 2023-24. The ceremony was attended by Principal Dr. Atonu Kakoty, Vice Principal Dr. Gautam Purkayastha, and faculty members from both departments, marking a significant achievement for the students.

(c) The Department of Commerce and Management at Margherita College jointly hosted an interactive program on February 22, 2024, focusing on 'Career Opportunities after Graduation in Commerce.' CA Shashi B. Goel, a seasoned Chartered Accountant from Tinsukia, Assam, engaged with sixth-semester B.Com students from both Accounts and Marketing groups, sharing insightful information and expert advice on the diverse career paths available to commerce graduates. The session provided valuable guidance and inspiration for students nearing the completion of their undergraduate studies.

(d) The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the Department of Commerce and Management at Margherita College, in collaboration with ICFAI Business School, hosted a Faculty Knowledge Sharing Programme on 'Innovations in Teaching and Learning Approaches' on October 7, 2023. The programme began with felicitations and a welcome address by Principal Dr. Atonu Kakoty, followed by an overview of the objectives by Mr. Anjan Kumar Bordoloi. Renowned experts, Prof. Subhanan Dey and Dr. Samprit Chakrabarti from ICFAI Business School, Kolkata, delivered insightful presentations, culminating in an engaging interactive session. The programme concluded with a vote of thanks by Mr. Mayur Singha and was skillfully anchored by Ms. Yemokhya Fakay, Coordinator of IQAC.

(e) Margherita College hosted a Student Development Programme (SDP) on 'Stress and Wellness: Finding Your Balance' on October 6, 2023, for 100 degree students. Prof. Subhanan Dey from ICFAI Business School, Kolkata, shared valuable insights as the key resource person. The event was a collaborative effort between IQAC, Department of Commerce and Management, and ICFAI Business School, aiming to equip students with stress management and wellness strategies.

(f) On April 2, 2024, Margherita College's Department of Commerce and Management, and Entrepreneurship Development Cell, in collaboration with TRTC, Tinsukia, organized an Industrial Exposure Visit Programme. Mr. Kalyan Dutta's presentation on start-up registrations and digital marketing was followed by a guided tour of industrial estates, including plastic, packaging, and printing factories. Faculty members Ms. Mayurakshi Ojah, Dr. Nitish Das, and Ms. Anisha Chakraborty accompanied the students.

## SELECTED ACTIVITIES FROM THE FACULTY OF SCIENCE, MARGHERITA COLLEGE:

(a) The Department of Anthropology at Margherita College organized two events: a field trip to Katha Gaon (Sept 30 - Oct 1, 2023) where 39 students conducted a household survey and socio-cultural study of the Sonowal Kacharis community, and a seminar at DHSK College (Feb 15, 2024) where three students presented research papers, showcasing their academic excellence on World Anthropology Day.

(b) The Department of Computer Science, in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Margherita College, hosted a one-day workshop on May 28, 2024, titled "Use of AI Language Model in Day-to-Day Life." Led by Mr. Poban Kamar, a renowned faculty member from the Department of Computer Science at Digboi College, the workshop explored the practical applications and benefits of AI language models in various aspects of daily life, making complex concepts accessible and captivating for all participants through his exceptional expertise and engaging presentation style.

(c) The Department of Physics at Margherita College hosted a Workshop on Optics (Jan 22-23, 2024) at the Physics Laboratory. The two-day event covered fundamental and advanced concepts in optics, bridging theory and practice, and provided hands-on experience with optical instruments. The workshop successfully equipped participants with a thorough understanding of optics and facilitated networking among like-minded individuals.

(d) The EVS Cell of Margherita College, in association with the Department of Zoology, observed International Biodiversity Day with the theme "Be a part of the plan" (Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework). Ms. Mousumi Kanwar, Assistant Professor of Zoology, delivered a lecture on biodiversity and its conservation, elucidating the targets of the Kunming-Montreal framework and emphasizing the importance of individual participation in preserving biodiversity and nature. Dr. Nitish Das, EVS cell coordinator, engaged in an interactive session with students from Arts, Science, and Commerce, making the program a resounding success.

(b) The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Margherita College organized a workshop on ERP Software on September 20, 2023, for over

300 students and 60 staff members. Mr. Bickram Sharma from S.S. Technologies provided expert training, covering core areas like Admission, Academic, and Administration. - (f) The Enrichment Cell of Margherita College marked Students' Day on March 31, 2024, commemorating the birth anniversary of Bodofa Upendra Nath Brahma.
- (g) The Enrichment Cell, Margherita College observed a Road Safety Awareness Programme on February 26, 2024, in collaboration with the Logistics Department, Oil India Limited, Duliajan, featuring an awareness lecture, quiz session, and street skit. In collaboration with the Department of Zoology, the cell also observed International Biodiversity Day on May 22, 2024, emphasizing the vital importance of conservation and sustainability, and inspiring a deeper appreciation for the natural world among students and faculty.

(s) NSS, Margherita College, has been actively engaged in various community service and awareness initiatives, including celebrating World Environment Day on June 5, 2023, organizing Career Counselling and Consultation on Education on June 8, 2023, and conducting a Fruits Distribution Programme among patients at Civil Hospital on June 23, 2023. Additionally, the team observed International Yoga Day on June 21, 2023, participated in a Peace March on the occasion of International Day of Non-Violence on October 2, 2023, and launched the Swachhta Hi Sewa Campaign from September 15 to October 2, 2023. Furthermore, they conducted a Campus Cleanliness Drive on September 24, 2023, and collaborated with Lions Club, Digboi, for a Plantation Programme on the same day, demonstrating their commitment to environmental awareness, community service, and promoting a culture of peace and non-violence.

(t) The Electoral Literacy Club at Margherita College organized several events to promote electoral awareness and voter education, including a quiz competition, National Voters' Day celebration, voter enrolment survey, voter registration camp, and voter awareness camp, held between December 2023 and February 2024, aiming to empower young voters and promote electoral literacy.
